COVID-19 Return to Play Plan - Amendment

Ensure processes are in place to exclude participants (including spectators and officials) if they have visited Victoria in the 14 days prior.

Evidence:

- Amended requirements to our COVID-19 safety plan emailed to all existing members on our participant database
- Amended requirements to our COVID-19 safety plan distributed to our Team App followers
- Amended requirements to our COVID-19 safety plan posted through our social media channels
- Amended requirements to our COVID-19 safety plan added to COVID-19 link on our website
- Amended requirements to our COVID-19 safety plan will be included in signage displayed in prominent locations at our facility
- Amended requirements to our COVID-19 safety plan will be included in hourly loud speaker announcements at our facility on game day

Ensure processes are in place to exclude participants (including spectators and officials) if they have attended any of the reported case locations listed on the NSW Health website.

Evidence:

- Amended requirements to our COVID-19 safety plan emailed to all existing members on our participant database
- Amended requirements to our COVID-19 safety plan distributed to our Team App followers
- Amended requirements to our COVID-19 safety plan posted through our social media channels
- Amended requirements to our COVID-19 safety plan added to COVID-19 link on our website
- Amended requirements to our COVID-19 safety plan will be included in signage displayed in prominent locations at our facility
- Amended requirements to our COVID-19 safety plan will be included in hourly loud speaker announcements at our facility on game day

Take all reasonable steps to minimise the number of spectators attending community sport events

Evidence:

- As per our existing COVID-19 safety plan, staggered game times, ovals in operations, reduced warm up times and leaving after playing will enable us to remain under the 500 capacity limit for an un-fenced facility
- Spectators will be limited to the direct family unit of participant (Parents/siblings/alternate caregiver)
- Amended requirements to our COVID-19 safety plan emailed to all existing members on our participant database
- Amended requirements to our COVID-19 safety plan distributed to our Team App followers
- Amended requirements to our COVID-19 safety plan posted through our social media channels
- Amended requirements to our COVID-19 safety plan added to COVID-19 link on our website
- Amended requirements to our COVID-19 safety plan will be included in signage displayed in prominent locations at our facility
- Amended requirements to our COVID-19 safety plan will be included in hourly loud speaker announcements at our facility on game day

If sufficient numbers to field teams cannot be achieved, prioritise delaying the event rather than substituting with people from other teams (clubs) or from the community

Evidence:

- Team numbers across all our age groups (6s to 15s) are at maximum and will be able to absorb occasions where there will be absences
- Each age group (6s to 15s) have multiple teams which are training together as per our approved COVID-19 training schedule and they will be utilised on the rare occasion where our existing team numbers cannot absorb absences
- The process outlined above is our club's normal process dealing with shortage in numbers, if the above process cannot achieve sufficient numbers to field teams the event will be delayed.

Please note:

- As the facility we operate is non-fenced we acknowledge that not all attendees will either see signage or hear announcements
- While distributing amended requirements through all our communication channels, we acknowledge that some club members and visiting non club members will not see or acknowledge attempted communications
