COVID-19 Return to Play Plan

FACILITIES

The club will provide details on how the facilities will operate, in accordance with the NSWRL Framework requirements. These should cover, but aren't limited to:

- Field 1, Field 2, Mini Field will be utilised for playing games, entry/exit point with hand sanitiser to playing area
- Change rooms will be open but only for access to toilets, no teams should be using
- Undercover area of clubhouse will be open, social distancing applies
- Clubhouse/Canteen will be open (covered off in Facilities – enclosed)
- Access will be limited by way of lock and key, signage, fencing
- Floor markers and wall signage will assist with social distancing
- Canteen will operate with preferred contactless payment, hand sanitisation stations, wearing of gloves and social distancing markers

FACILITIES (ENCLOSED)

Where a club wishes to open and operate an enclosed facility such as a club house or bar area, they should provide specific details of:

- Attendance register will be maintained for all club officials on game day
- Attendance register and Hand Sanitisation station will be provided for all spectators
- Canteen and BBQ area will be limited to 4 persons (due to square meter rule) and this will be signposted

FACILITIES (OUTDOORS)

For all outdoor training and playing activity, the club should provide information on:

- Only essential participants (registered players and team staff) will have access to playing area
- All other spectators will be instructed to practice good social distancing (signage/social media) and arrive just before kick off and leave straight after full time.
- Maximum amount of people allowed at the venue will be 500, this will be managed by extended gaps between game times and staggering draw times

- Attendance register and Hand Sanitisation station will be provided for all spectators

SOCIAL DISTANCING

The club will:

- Develop and implement social distancing guidelines and requirements for all areas of the venue, this will be communicated through signage and our other communication channels.
- Maximum number signage in all closed areas, change rooms will remain closed and floor markers to assist canteen area

HYGIENE

The club should provide details on hygiene protocols required in the NSWRL Framework and how they will be implemented. Including but not limited to:

- Education posters required by the Government guidelines and provided to each club in the NSWRL Starter Pack will be displayed in prominent places the education posters
- Hand sanitisation station:
 - At entry/exit to venue
 - At entry/exit to playing area
 - At point of sale areas
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PERSONAL HEALTH

Club should provide details on personal health protocols for all participants that should cover:

- Education on the COVID-19 NSWRL framework has been completed with all teams, coaching staff and committee members.
